### About PathFinders

PathFinders ([www.pathfinders.org.hk](http://www.pathfinders.org.hk)) is a Hong Kong-registered charity. We work to ensure that the most vulnerable children born in Hong Kong, and their migrant mothers, are respected and protected. We believe that every child born in Hong Kong deserves a fair start in life. We empower migrant worker mothers to make informed life decisions and to find a dignified path towards a legal, safe and sustainable future. We are a strong team of social workers, lawyers, health care professionals and volunteers that form seven programs that support our clients on their way to a brighter future. The programs are Mothers' Protection Program, Child Protection program, Access to Healthcare, Access to Justice, PathFinders Shelter, Community Outreach and Education.

### About the Access to Healthcare Program

Our small Access to Healthcare Team help our clients to get access to healthcare when they are denied by the public healthcare system. Through our Health Centre we perform basic pregnancy check ups, support and educate the mothers through pregnancy, birth, breastfeeding and with baby care. We work together with a small team of doctors that see our clients pro bono or to a reduced fee. We perform postnatal home visits to ensure that the child is brought up in a safe environment, and help the women to get access to contraceptives to prevent unplanned pregnancy.

### Job responsibilities include:

Contribute to, and develop all Access to Healthcare services

- Provide basic medical pre- and postnatal checkups at PathFinders' Health Centre. Lead supportive and empowering one-to-one talks with clients
- Perform postnatal home visits to clients homes and assist them with advice on breastfeeding, baby care, parenting, hygiene and safety.
- Accompany clients to Family Planning Association, Doctor appointments, and hospital visits
- Train and lead programme volunteers and interns along with conducting client training
- Continually evaluate the effectiveness of all Access to Healthcare services and contribute to implement changes and develop the program as needed
- Develop and maintain relationships with healthcare organizations and providers
- Be comfortable collaborating and communicating with a multi- professional and cultural team

### Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree, or higher in midwifery or nursing specialized in obstetrics/gynecology.
- Preferably registered as a nurse/midwife in Hong Kong

- Experience in non-profit/NGO program management preferable
- English required, Cantonese or Bahasa Indonesian preferred
- Willingness to assertively advocate for PathFinders' clients' human right to healthcare
- Commitment to the mission of PathFinders
- Flexibility in travel throughout Hong Kong with occasional weekend and evening hours required
- A good team communicator and a quick learner with good organizational and problem-solving skills

PathFinders works closely with other agencies who provide services to vulnerable children and migrant women in Hong Kong including, Mothers Choice, Christian Action, Health in Action and Mission for Migrant Workers. We also collaborate, build understanding and relationships with Government departments and related organizations including International Social Services, public hospitals, Social Welfare Department, Hospital Authority and the Immigration Department.
