

Privacy Policy

1. General

- i. We, PathFinders Limited ("PathFinders") shall at all times comply with the requirements of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486) ("the Ordinance"). We make this statement to notify you why personal data is collected, how it will be used and to whom data access requests are to be addressed.
- ii. In order to preserve the confidentiality of all personal data you provide to us, PathFinders maintains the following privacy principles:
 - a. You are under no obligation to provide any personal data.
 - b. We only collect your personal data that we believe to be relevant and required to provide our services through or by this Website.
 - c. We may pass your personal data to other companies or our agents, as permitted by law.
 - d. We will not disclose your personal data to any external organisation unless we have your consent or are required by law or have previously informed you.
