2. It is obligatory for the applicant to provide the information required. Failure to provide such data may affect the processing and outcome of your application.
3. The provision of personal data to PF is voluntary. If you do not provide sufficient data, we may not be able to process your application.
4. The personal data that you provide will be made available to PF personnel on a need-to-know basis.

6. It is our policy to retain certain personal data of volunteers when they cease to serve as volunteers for a period of two years.
